Embarrassment comes when your self worth is threatened.

What is God's answer to the fear of embarrassment?

1. God wants you to know you have infinite worth.

A. God created you in His image.

And God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Genesis 1:27

B. God thinks so highly of you.

Since you are precious in My sight, since you are honored and I love you... Isaiah 43:4

C. God gave His only Son for you.

...who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me. Galatians 2:20

2. God wants you to know you have incredible wealth.

A. You are a saint of God.

...to all who are beloved of God... called as saints. Romans 1:7

B. You are blessed with every spiritual blessing.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ. Ephesians 1:3

3. God wants you to know you have indescribable rewards.

A. You will spend eternity with God.

Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, and which have not entered the heart of man, all that God has prepared for those who love Him. 1 Corinthians 2:9

B. You will be made just like Jesus.
